In December my brother Doug, friend Robin and I had an amazing time in Ghana. The purpose of the trip was to visit and encourage our staff there, document the mission and investigate investment opportunities. All three objectives were accomplished by His grace.

Our all-staff luncheon was fun, as the staff sang, danced, and prayed loudly. Doug, Robin, and I gave some encouraging words to the staff and assured them that we and you are supporting them as we move into the new year.

We took many of pictures and videos and have been able to share some of them with various groups since returning and hope to continue throughout the year. Watch for more pictures and stories in the newsletters later this year. A Highlight of the trip was distributing soccer balls to 4 schools, an orphanage, and a poor village. We also gave rice and cooking oil to the orphanage and village for which they were all very thankful. We accompanied our hospital team and prayed for the sick and shared the Gospel with many. This was a meaningful experience and will not soon be forgotten. We investigated a mature 6-acre cocoa farm that was for sale. The seller has won awards for his skillful farming and high production. He agreed to give us until the end of January to raise the \$15,000 needed to make this purchase. Praise the Lord! We have raised the necessary funds and are working on closing the purchase later this month.

Thank you for your prayers for us. There is a 25-year celebration already being planned for 2025.
